Re: "Swine Flu"

The Health Protection Agency has advised us that there has been one confirmed case of 'swine flu' in a student at LBTS. There are no more cases currently under investigation or being treated as presumed cases. The child is recovering well.

The advice to schools is to remain open. We will therefore remain open until the last day of term on Friday 17 July at 3.05pm.

If your child shows any flu like symptoms please take them to your GP as soon as possible. If 'swine flu' is diagnosed you should let Nana Boakye (Attendance Officer) know on 0207 091 9500.

If your child becomes ill during the day we will ensure we contact you as soon as possible so you can arrange to collect your child and take him/her to your GP.

Lastly the advice from the Health Protection Agency is very clear. Only those who have swine flu or who have the symptoms of swine flu should stay away from school. Everybody else should attend school as normal. July is an important period in the school year during which Y10/11 complete GCSE coursework and Y/9 start their new courses. I therefore hope you will ensure your child, if not ill, is in school.
